ADVERTISEMENT FOR JUNIOR RESIDENT (NON-ACAD.) POSTS

Subject: Recruitment to the post of Junior Resident (Non-Academic) session January, 2018 i.e. from 01.02.2018 to 30.07.2018 at the AIIMS, Patna.

The All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Patna is an Autonomous Body established under an Act of Parliament. As a part of its activities the Institute is running a large teaching hospital for training of undergraduate and postgraduate students in the various fields of Medical Sciences.

APPLICATIONS are invited from Indian Citizens (including OCI/PIO) for the posts of Junior Residents (Non-Academic) in different specialities as indicated below in level 10 of pay matrix (pre-revised pay band-3, Rs.15600/- + 5400/-(GP)) with entry pay of Rs. 56,100/- per month plus usual allowances as admissible, in the prescribed format and on the terms & conditions given in detail on Institute website – www.aiimspatna.org. Last date for submission of application for these posts is **23.01.2018**.



RESERVATION OF POSTS

- 1) The reservation for ST/SC/OBC candidates is as per Central Govt. rules and 5% for PWD including OPH candidates (on horizontal basis).
- 2) **For OBC Candidate:** Candidates must attach certificate valid for the posts under the **Central Government of India** which mentions that the Candidate does not belong to Creamy Layer. Date of issue of Certificate should not be earlier than 1 year from the last date of submission of Application Form for Junior Residency **which is 23.01.2018**.
- 3) For SC, ST & OBC – Certificate should be issued by authorities prescribed by Govt. of India.
- 4) **For PWD:**
 PWD candidate including OPH may be considered for January, 2018 session as per PWD Act'2016. 5% reservation (on horizontal basis) of total posts is implemented. Therefore, 10 posts are reserved for non-dental posts. However, candidate shall be allowed to join only after medical fitness certification by duly constituted Medical Board.
 - i) The candidate must possess a valid document certifying his/her physical disability is conforming to judgment of Supreme Court of India i.e.: "With the approval of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India vide letter no. 18018/2/2009-ME(P-1) dated 17.02.2009 it has been decided that while providing reservation in admission to medical course in the first instance candidates with disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% shall be considered and in case candidates are not available of such candidates in that category then the candidates with disability of lower limbs between 40% to 50% will also be considered for admission as per decision in the Writ Petition (Civil) 184/2005-Dr.Kumar Sourav Vs. UOI & others in the Supreme Court of India".
 - ii) The disability certificate should be signed by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board of the State or Central Govt. Hospitals/Institutions & countersigned by Medical Superintendent.
 - iii) The constitution of the Medical Board will include consultants from related disciplines.



TERMS & CONDITIONS

A. THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1) The candidates should have passed MBBS/BDS (including completion of Internship) or equivalent degree recognized by MCI/DCI.
- 2) Those who are completing compulsory rotatory internship on 31.01.2018 will also be allowed provisionally.
- 3) Only those candidates who have passed MBBS/BDS (including Internship) not earlier than three years before the start date of Junior Residency (Non-Academic) i.e. 01.02.2018 will be considered. It implies that those who have completed MBBS/BDS or equivalent course (including INTERNSHIP) **between 1.1.2015 to 01.02.2018 only will be considered.**
- 4) MCI/State Registration is mandatory before joining, if selected.
- 5) Those who had joined Junior Residency (Non-Academic) at the AIIMS and whose services were terminated on account of unauthorised absence or any other disciplinary/ground, will be ineligible to be considered for these JR (NA) post even if they otherwise qualify.
- 6) For all eligible candidates, maximum three terms* are allowed (one term is of 6 months duration). Candidates who have already done 3 terms* of Junior Residency (Non-Academic) either at AIIMS or outside will not be considered. Experience in Army Services, Central Health Services, Private Nursing Homes and Private Practice will be taken as equivalent to Junior Residency (Non-Academic).
- 7) UPPER AGE_LIMIT (as on date of written examination) will be 33 years
 - (i) Relax able for SC/ST candidates up to a maximum period of five years and in the case of OBC candidates up to a maximum period of three years.
 - (ii) In the case of Orthopaedic/ Physical Handicapped (OPH) candidates up to a maximum period of 5 years for UR, 8 Years for OBC and 10 years for SC/ST category candidates.

Note (*): Term of JR (Non-Acad.) is 6 months, if any one join and leaves at any time it will be counted as one term irrespective of duration of work.

B. METHOD OF RECRUITMENT:

Written Examination (MCQ Based Test) will be conducted at College of Nursing, AIIMS, Patna on 29th January, 2018 at 10.00am. The candidate should report to the venue between 9-10 am. The candidate should bring two copies of the photographs, similar to that of pasted on application form, at the time of examination. No mobile/cell phones, calculators and any items will be allowed to carry in the examination hall. Bring BLUE or BLACK BALL POINT PEN only. Further instructions will be given at the time of written test.

- a. The merit order of the candidates will be on the basis of rank scores obtained in written examination and aggregate percentage of marks obtained in the MBBS examination.

- b. For Indian Citizens (including OCI/PIO), who have completed their MBBS from a medical college outside India and have passed the MCI screening test for registration, marks obtained in percentage in the MCI screening exam will be considered for merit. These students must enter the MCI exam percentage at the appropriate place in the online application form. They must not enter percentile scores obtained in the MBBS course.
4. The candidates in order of merit will be allotted department of their choice subject to availability of posts at the time of joining. In case of absentee, the next candidate in merit will be considered.
5. PWD candidates, who apply will be considered against posts in category in which he/she has applied i.e. UR/SC/ST or OBC. Last post/s in the respective category will be offered to PWD candidates, (in case PWD candidate is not able to make on his/her their own merit). However, candidate shall be allowed to join only after medical fitness certification by duly constituted Board.
6. The waiting list for this session will be valid till next Recruitment of JR (Non-Acad.).
7. The number of vacancies indicated against each post/category is provisional and may vary at the time of selection.


C. GENERAL CONDITIONS


1. **Application Process:** The applicants fulfilling the eligibility criteria in all respect are required to download the prescribed application form, which can be downloaded from AIIMS Patna website <http://www.aiimspatna.org> or <http://www.aiimspatne.edu.in>.
2. A print out of the prescribed application format, duly filled in all respect, duly signed along with application fee (as applicable) in the form of Demand Draft in original and self-attested copies of all educational qualification, age proof, reserve category document (if applicable), rotary internship completion certificate of the institute of internship, and medical registration document must reach the Institute on or before 23.01.2018 till 5 P.M.. The completed application may be sent through **speed post/registered post/Courier Service to the Recruitment Cell, All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Phulwarisharif, Patna – 801507**. The institute shall not be responsible for any postal delay. **Application not received within the due date shall be rejected.** No correspondence in this regard shall be made by institute.
3. The applicants are required to pay a non-refundable application fee of **Rs.1000/- (for General & OBC Candidates)** and no fee for **SC/ST/PH and women candidates**, in form of Demand Draft (DD) drawn in favour of **AIIMS PATNA** payable at Patna. The application fee can also be sent through NEFT in the Account no. 579310110002528 (IFSC code: BKID0005793 Account Name: **AIIMS Patna**). Applicant should mention their particulars (Name, Address and position applied) on the reverse of DD. The receipt of NEFT should be attached with the application.
4. Application fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstance.
5. The applicants are required to fill the details of Demand Draft (DD) or NEFT in the space provided in the prescribed application form.
6. The applicants are instructed to keep a photo copy of the prescribed duly filled in application form and payment details for their own record.



7. The applicants applying in response to this advertisement should satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility for the post applied for. They must be fulfilling eligibility criteria as on the closing date of application failing which their application may be rejected.
