10:00-12:00	<u>Divide room into three teams</u> Each team selects a research question and picks a moderator who will collect FGD data <u>Hands on:</u> Development of FGD topic guide and recorded practice discussion (5 minute recordings only)
12:00-1:00	Introduction to ATLAS.ti: Qualitative Data Analysis Software
1:00-2:00	<i>Lunch</i>
2.00-3.00	Transcription and translation of FGD recordings
3.15 – 4.15	<u>Hands on:</u> Sample analysis of one transcript using Grounded Theory <i>Homework:</i> Develop Codebook for Grounded Theory for all practice transcripts
Time (3 rd Day)	27 th October – Saturday
9:00-9:30	Re-cap of day two: Review Codebooks and Grounded Theory framework
9:30-11:00	Introduction to key Informant and In-depth interviews - Videos and other supplementary materials
11:00-11.30	<u>Hands on:</u> Get into original FGD teams. Each team selects one pair of participants to practice in-depth interviews for the selected research question (5 minute recordings each with other team members taking notes) Provide feedback on in-depth interviews as facilitators walk around and other team members offer notes on what went well during the interview and what could be improved.

11.30-1:00	Transcription and translation of 5 minutes in-depth interviews (all members of the 3 teams transcribe and translate their team's in-depth interview)
1:00-2:00	<i>Lunch</i>
2.00-3.00	Develop Codebook for in-depth interviews and analyse data using Grounded Theory
3.15 – 4.15	ORAL GROUP PRESENTATIONS on research findings
	Debriefing and final feedback
